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Q: SA [redacted] 173
A: SA [redacted]
Q: What unit originally captured [redacted]
A: I believe he was picked up by the ICDC and then turned over to U.S. forces in AL ASAD. I can't remember what unit. 170
Q: Where was [redacted] detained prior to arriving at the BIAP?
A: We first met him at the AL ASAD Air Base. 170
Q: Did you interview [redacted] at the AL ASAD Air Base?
A: Yes, on 29 Feb 04. 170
Q: Do you have any knowledge of [redacted] being abused at the AL ASAD Air Base prior to you interviewing him?
A: No. 170
Q: Did [redacted] have any visible injuries when you interviewed him at the AL ASAD Air Base on 29 Feb 04?
A: Not that weren't a hundred years old. He was just messy and dirty. 170
Q: Did [redacted] make any complaints to you about being abused at AL ASAD?
A: No. He just said his back was sore from sleeping on a hard floor. 170
Q: When was the next time you interviewed [redacted]
A: A few days later at the BIAP. 170
Q: Who escorted [redacted] to the BIAP from AL ASAD?
A: I think it was SA [redacted] on a helicopter. 170
Q: Did [redacted] have any visible injuries when you interviewed him at the BIAP?
A: No. He was just dirty and had no shoes. 170
Q: Prior to interviewing [redacted] did you ever sign for him on a DD Form 2708?
A: Yes. 170
Q: Do you know why [redacted] was received back on a DD Form 2708 with "minor bruising and scratches"?
A: No, I don't know why it's listed there. The writing on the DD Form 2708 "received in good health" and "with minor bruising and scratches" looks different to me. He had no injuries when we received him or brought him back. He had no shoes so SA [redacted] bought him some. 170
Q: Did [redacted] make any complaints to you about abuse when you interviewed at him at the BIAP?
A: No. 170
Q: What kind of interrogation techniques did you use while interviewing [redacted]
A: He sat in a chair and we would sit semi-circular around him. We would throw different questions at him quickly to confuse him. We would ask general questions and then throw one in that was pertinent to see if he would slip up. It was a relaxed as it could be. The only thing we did was yell and that was during the questioning to confuse him. 170
Q: How was [redacted] and treated during your interviews?
A: He was treated professionally. We gave him food. Let him take breaks and use the latrine when he needed to. 170
Q: Did you ever complete any interrogation reports on [redacted] after interviewing him?
A: Yes after the 29 Feb 04 interview. It was provided to you by SA [redacted]. 170
Q: Are there any more reports concerning [redacted]?
A: Not that I've seen or written. 170
Q: Did you photograph or video tape [redacted] prior to or after the interviews?
A: Prior to the interview on 29 Feb 04 he was fingerprinted and photographed. To the best of my knowledge they should be located with the original file at the BIAP. 170
Q: Who conducted the interviews of [redacted] with you?
A: SA [redacted] and SA [redacted] 170
