At the time, I was told he had an ulcer and that the stress was irritating it. I was later advised he had a stomach virus. I was told he had been given a shot of Motrin (or something like that) by the medical staff.

My actions: Due in part to the fact that LTC was present and did not object to the situation, and I never heard 661 asked to be returned to his cell or request medical assistance, I b7c took no action.
