	dati em wha	ere were 530 employees who have served in some capacity at GTMO and were notified by email. To e, 478 have responded. Some employees have since retired and others were contractors no longer ployed with the Bureau. Of the 478 responses, there were 26 employees who stated they observed at was believed to be some form of mistreatment. These 26 employees provided summaries of what y actually observed. There were no observations of any mistreatment of detainees by FBI personnel.
