~~(S)~~ Update on the Attack on the Mosul Dining Facility: The post blast investigation was complete on 23 December 2004. The initial report indicated an IED, possible suicide attack. Additional information from the military supports this conclusion. [Redacted]

~~(S/NF, OC)~~ Update on Fallujah Sensitive Site Exploitation: FBI Agents that were deployed to the Sensitive Site Exploitation (SSE) in Fallujah returned to Balad without incident. Initial report indicates no human remains were recovered. There was no evidence found which would indicate Spc [Redacted] was buried at that location. Initial reports from local nationals forwarded by the military indicated a body clothed in a Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) and wearing military issue combat boots was partially uncovered by weather and then covered again by local nationals. This information was received several months ago but could not be acted on due to the security situation in Fallujah. The SSE deployed with 1MEF to the location and excavated the site without success. Efforts

to locate and recover Spc [redacted] or his remains continue. Additional details will be forwarded as soon as they are made available.

(U) ~~(S)~~ [redacted] On 21, December 2004, [redacted] was detained by members of the First Calvary Division in Baghdad, Iraq after a patrol discovered an abandoned vehicle and reported the vehicle as a possible VBIED. While inspecting the abandoned vehicle, [redacted] arrived with three LNs in a taxicab and advise the patrol that he had returned with help to recover his broken-down vehicle. Soldiers recovered two AK-47 assault rifles, one 9mm Glock pistol and two U.S. Military outer protective vests with sapper plates from inside [redacted] vehicle. The patrol turned [redacted] over to a Military Intelligence Officer and CID Agents. [redacted] was interviewed by CID agents who verified his credentials and identifications. CID agents felt that [redacted] was less than forthcoming about his reasons for being in Iraq, at which time, CID agents requested [redacted] be interviewed by the FBI. On 23 December 2004, members of the BOC interviewed [redacted]. It was determined thru interview that [redacted] was in Iraq as a contractor and had no intentions in utilizing his vehicle as a VBIED, or posed any threat to coalition forces.
