Val - Toni has reviewed all relevant IIS information and has determined that the only allegations against FBI employees were 1) those made by [redacted] and 2) information provided by SA [redacted] implicating SA [redacted]. [redacted] was turned over to the OIG without any investigation by IIS. SA [redacted] was interviewed by IIS to round out the allegation against [redacted]. SA [redacted] alleged that SA [redacted] as the officer in charge of a detention facility should have known of the conditions. IIS did not open an investigation in this matter, but provided the results of the [redacted] interview to the OIG. I hope this clarifies things. Let me know if you need anything further. [redacted]
