Mr. Kelley,

I spoke to [redacted] this morning regarding the DoD request and the existence of the [redacted] Documents" that [redacted] referred to. [redacted] will look into what, if any, documents these may be. I also told [redacted] that I would provide him with a copy of the request from DoD as contained in the 02/20/05 letter, which I will do shortly. In reviewing the last paragraph of that letter, I see that the request "for any additional information, verbal or written, made by FBI personnel relating to allegations of detainee abuse at GTMO, the Iraq theater and the Afghanistan theater, or any other location that would involve DoD personnel or detainees held by DoD" is huge in scope and would require a Bureau-wide effort/process, and probably not just a review of any documents [redacted] may have beyond the FOIA production.

Also as we discussed, I have given to [redacted] a copy of the email that you and I discussed from [redacted] and dated May 18, 2004.
