The attached is a DRAFT of a memo that is headed through DoD channels to the White House in preparation for a decision whether the detainee will be tried by the Military Tribunal.

According to our attorney down in GTMO, this is going to be handled through the same DoD channel that leaked the Harrington letter back before Christmas, so we should anticipate that this might leak. Our people in GTMO are, at a minimum, going to ask Gen. Hood to make clear in the memo that the techniques described were done by DoD, NOT FBI. We are also triple checking that we had no involvement with the techniques.

As indicated in the memo, we did have involvement with the detainee both after and before DoD. [REDACTED]

d. (U) 23 November 2002 transferred permanently to X-Ray for ease of interrogation and waiting authority to use new techniques (7 - 9 Dec as a precautionary measure, was under observation at NAVBASE Hospital. [redacted])

e. (U) 16 January 2003 transported back to NAVBASE Brig due to Sec Def rescinding use of special techniques (category II and one category III) previously approved for use at Guantanamo Bay in his 02 December 2002 approval of action memo dated 27 November 2002 (see enclosure 1). (16 -19 Feb 2003 was held at NAVBASE Hospital due to a hunger strike)

f. (U) 24 February 2003 moved to Camp Echo a new segregation/isolation facility.

g. (U) 18 March 2003 transferred back to the NAVBASE Brig. Reason unknown.

h. (U) 12 September 2003 returned to Camp Echo at request of FBI.

i. (U) 27 May 2004 transferred to Camp V newest detention facility for most high value detainees where he has remained.

4. (U) Interrogation Information

a. (U) Facilities. ISN 063 was interrogated in the detention facilities described in enclosure 2. In addition, during the time detainee was in Camp Delta, he was interrogated in Yellow and Brown buildings. These facilities are modular offices with standardized interrogation rooms with adjacent observation rooms.

b. (U) Interrogation Techniques. Techniques used were: duration of interrogation, removal from social support, habits of compliance, habits of conversation, stress induction, social segregation, and use of environment (see enclosure 3). Specific approaches used in the application of those interrogation techniques that might be considered contentious and merit discussion is below:

5. (U) Medical Treatment. The detainee suffered minor medical problems from October 2002 to March 2003; corresponding with the period he was under intense interrogation. These issues were in the main due to the sporadic fasting that the detainee did during this period (lasting for 5 to 6 days at a time), sleep deprivation caused by lengthy interrogation periods, and slight abrasions caused by stress positions and shackle restraints. His weight during this period fluctuated [redacted] He in-processed into Guantanamo [redacted] Throughout the period he received frequent monitoring by qualified medical personnel. Medical personnel were particularly watchful during the detainee's self-imposed fasts.

6. (U) Disciplinary Actions Taken. Since being moved to Camp V, the detainee has had nine disciplinary reports, including damage to property and possession of contraband. Before his move to Camp V, records indicate three significant activity reports concerning the detainee. One report describes a lengthy exchange between a guard and the detainee where ISN 063 [redacted] to go to America because of his knowledge of computers and English. ISN 063 reportedly told the guard that he trained with the September 11th hijackers but did not deploy with them, and was later caught by Saudi Arabia agents, questioned, and then detained. Disciplinary actions taken against the detainee were the removal of comfort items (see enclosure 14). The guard force currently assesses ISN 063 as non-compliant with camp rules.

7. (U) Allegations of Abuse and Investigations. Allegations of abuse concerning ISN 063 have come from two sources: the detainee himself and from a letter written by Mr. T.J. Harrington, FBI Deputy Assistant Director, Counterterrorism Center. Mr. T.J. Harrington's letter, dated July 14, 2004, refers to use of a canine during interrogations and isolation. The detainee made his allegations in a recent interview with the ICRC. He reported that 10 months to a year ago he was being moved back and forth between X-Ray and the Navy Brig for interrogations. He complained that abuse during the interrogations included: forced positions, cold water, Koran abuse, and denial of prayer, sexual humiliation, and threat of homosexual intercourse. Both sets of allegations are currently under investigation by LTG Schmidt, who was appointed by the Commander, US Southern Command.

8. (S) Summary. We compiled the information in this report by searching JTF-GTMO databases, hard copy documents, and reviewing past reports. What we have sent is material that amplifies the contents of this executive summary. We have [redacted] of
