We have recently completed the reprocessing of 87 pages in the Foreign Detainee case because we determined information that was previously withheld can now be released. Most of the newly-released information is unremarkable as it consists of names and investigations that are no longer on-going; two issues, however warrant your attention. The first issue is that we have

determined that the name of the on-scene commander in GTMO; Ed Leuckenhoff, should be released because we had released it elsewhere and he was the ASAC (a level at which we normally release names) Dallas at the time. The reason this is even an issue is that he is being identified as the author of the email (Bates number 1640) that erroneously cites an Executive Order as authorizing certain interrogation techniques such as "sleep management", use of military working dogs and others; there is no such order. Ed Leuckenhoff retired in December. The second issue worth noting is that we are releasing an internal CTD email that has the phrase "impersonation of DOD interrogators at Guantanamo representing themselves to be officials of the FBI and U.S. State Department".
