Moezzem Begg said that "they said", then he said it was "possibly [redacted] said 'Iqbal Shaik II Libi, the alQaeda member, who had been captured ... in 2001... was sitting here playing the same games you are. We sent him to Egypt and he broke within two days. You're going to Egypt too.' Moazzem Begg said he was led to believe that because he was continuing to ask about his family's welfare, [redacted] had a photo of Moazzem Begg's child that was made from information on Moazzem Begg's computer, and he waived it in front of Moazzem Begg saying that he would never see that's again. [redacted] would ask Moazzem Begg, "don't you care for your family? Don't you care for your wife?" Shortly after that, Moazzem Begg heard the screams of a woman, but he was "too afraid to ask the question, because he was too afraid of the answer, but several detainees downstairs, who also heard the screaming, also said... we were so afraid that it was your wife they had in custody, and they were using this technique on you." Muazzam Begg said that it was rumored through other detainees that the blows that caused his death were given to him in the isolation unit.
